Candidates can apply for more than one graduate course in the same admissions cycle, so the number of applications submitted exceeds the number of individuals who applied in any particular year.

### **OVERVIEW**

Applications for graduate study have increased by nearly 115% over the last ten years, up from 13,500 applications for 2008-09 entry to over 29,000 for 2018-19.

The University's graduate student community has also grown by 46% over the last ten years to more than 11,000 graduate students in 2018, comprising half of Oxford's student body.



9,417 applications (32.4%) were for graduate research degrees

**19,674** applications (67.6%) were for graduate taught degrees

## **DIVISIONS, DEPARTMENTS AND FACULTIES**

The University of Oxford's academic departments and faculties are organised into four academic divisions and the Department for Continuing Education.

Taught programmes include the majority of Oxford's one- and two-year masters' courses and its postgraduate diplomas and certificates. Research programmes are primarily DPhil (PhD) and MSc by Research courses.

Offer statistics include all conditional or unconditional offers made by academic departments or faculties of the University of Oxford.

Acceptance statistics represent candidates who completed all admissions processes and were ready to enrol.

All graduate students at the University of Oxford are members of both an academic department and one of the University's colleges, except for non-matriculated students.

Non-matriculated students are students on specific postgraduate certificate and diploma courses, usually within the Department for Continuing Education, who do not have a college affiliation and do not attend a matriculation ceremony at the start of the course.

Permanent Private Halls (PPHs) are licensed by the University to matriculate students for degrees. They were founded by various Christian denominations and retain their religious character.
