## **OPEN Fellowship Scheme**

Applicants to this scheme must also demonstrate in their proposal how the Fellowship will contribute to:

- The professional development of the Fellow, including details of the skills and experience the Fellow will develop, how those will be developed, and how the host will support integration of the Fellow within the host.
- Building capacity for academic-policy engagement within the Host organisation.
